Theme of conference: «Navigating a World in Transition: Sustainable Solutions for Global Resilience».

### 1. Security Council (UNSC) - English language

- a. Addressing the Role of Private Military Contractors in Conflict Zones: Discussing regulations and oversight on the growing use of private military forces and their impact on global security.
- b. Climate-Induced Conflict: Managing Displacement and Resource Scarcity. Examining the Security Council's role in preventing and responding to conflicts triggered by climate change, particularly concerning refugees and competition over natural resources.

## 2. Disarmament and International Security Committee (DISEC) - English language

- a. The Threat of Emerging Technologies in Modern Warfare: Drones and Autonomous Weapons. Discussing international regulations for the use of autonomous weapons and drones in warfare, balancing security concerns with technological advancements.
- b. Cybersecurity in an Increasingly Digital World: Preventing International Cyber Conflict. Addressing how states can cooperate to prevent cyberattacks that threaten global peace and security, especially with growing reliance on digital infrastructure.

## 3. Human Rights Committee (UNHRC): English language + Russian Language

- a. The Right to Asylum in an Era of Climate Change: Protecting Climate Refugees. Deliberating the recognition and protection of people displaced by climate-induced disasters under international human rights law.
- b. Human Rights in the Age of Surveillance: Balancing Security and Privacy. Exploring the impact of advanced surveillance technologies on the right to privacy and civil liberties, particularly in the context of national security.

## 4. Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (CCPCJ): English language

- a. Combating Environmental Crime: Tackling Illegal Wildlife Trafficking and Pollution. Focusing on the rise of transnational environmental crime, such as illegal wildlife trade and industrial pollution, and strategies for international cooperation in crime prevention.
- b. Addressing the Criminalization of Digital Crimes: Cybercrime and Financial Fraud. Discussing international frameworks to combat the rise of cybercrime, particularly financial fraud, ransomware, and hacking of critical infrastructure.

#### 5. General Assembly: English language

- a. Non-Proliferation in an Age of Uncertainty: Adapting to New Nuclear Threats. Reviewing the global non-proliferation regime in light of emerging nuclear threats, including advancements in delivery systems and geopolitical instability.
- b. Technological Disruption and Arms Control: Regulating the Militarization of Space. Debating international regulations for the prevention of an arms race in outer space, especially given the increasing reliance on satellite technologies for defense.

## 6. United Nations Development Programme (UNDP): English language + Kazakh Language

- a. Sustainable Development in Conflict Zones: Building Resilience in Fragile States. Discussing strategies for promoting sustainable development in countries affected by conflict and instability, with a focus on rebuilding infrastructure and governance.
- b. Adapting to Technological Disruptions: Leveraging Innovation for Climate Resilience. Exploring how technological innovations, such as renewable energy and AI, can be harnessed to enhance climate resilience in vulnerable communities and developing countries.
